Article 76 Points

- x Point on the territorial sea baseline
- o Sediment thickness formula point
- o Salient 2500 m depth point
- o Point on the depth constraint
- o Point on the distance constraint

Article 76 Lines

- Outer edge of the continental margin
- Depth constraint (2500 meters + 100 M)
- Distance constraint (350 M)
- Outer limits of the continental shelf

Maritime Limits & Boundaries

- U.S. 200 M
- Canada 200 M
- U.S.-Russia maritime boundary
- U.S.-Canada equidistant line (within 200 M)
